

Een strategic game for 2 players, 7 years and up.

Duration: up to 30 minutes.


Content:

- 1 wooden game board.
- 2 light balls.
- 20 dark balls.

(Balls can be in reverse order – 2 dark balls and 20 light balls)

Preparation:

- Arrange the game board as instructed in the diagram.
- The players must decide who will use the light balls (the foxes) and who will use the dark balls (the sheep).
- The player who plays the light balls goes first.




Object of the Game:

• The foxes player's objective is to remove 12 of the sheep from the game board.

The sheeps player's objective is to conquer the 9 slots that make the top square of the board (green line).





Playing the Game:

The player who plays the light balls (sheep) goes first. Each player gets one turn at a time and must make one move in each turn.

- The foxes may move in a straight or diagonal line, taking one step in each trun. They may also move backwards.
 - They remove sheep from the game board by jumping over them, one at a time, in a manner similar to checkers straight or diagonal lines.
- The sheep may move forwards or to the sides, taking one step in each turn. **They cannot move** backwards or diagonally.
 - They protect themselves by moving into the empty slots behind them and making sure that the foxes cannot jump over them.
- The foxes need to try and block the sheep from reaching the top square of the board.
- The sheep need to look out and try and prevent the foxes from leaping over them and removing them from the board.

To make the game more interesting try playing it once as the sheep and once as the foxes.
